It is estimated that as much as 80% of litter found at sea originates from land sources. This means that 20% originates from maritime businesses whilst an estimated 28% of the top 100 most common plastic items found at sea are commonly used by commercial vessels.

Whilst legislative frameworks, scientific advances, and local availability are slowly catching up with industry needs and demands, our findings have evidenced the need for multifaced concrete and coordinated actions.
